Burton Court has first-class staff and facilities to help support our ladies and gentlemen in a welcoming and friendly home with comfortable communal areas and spacious, fully furnished bedrooms. Spread over two floors, with lift access for those with impaired mobility.

Our home is a well-established extensive Victorian property with 20 bedrooms. These are all fully furnished; however, we encourage everyone to decorate and furnish to their own personal taste. We have a beautiful large, private garden with accessible spaces for quiet reflection and a thriving gardening club. On the ground floor a large communal lounge perfect for meaningful and stimulating daily activities and a large, light and airy dining room.

Our ladies and gentlemen are encouraged to maintain their independence and pursue active, meaningful lives amongst friends.
